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The Associate of Arts degree (A.A) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower-division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours; please see [JCCC A.A. degree requirements](#). Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses. *120 hours are required for graduation with a B.S. in Personal Financial Planning at K-State.

- The College of Health and Human Sciences at K-State offers a major in Personal Financial Planning with the following track options: Family Financial Planning, Sales, Entrepreneurship or Integrated Investment Management.
- The Personal Financial Planning program is registered with the Certified Financial Planner Board of Standards, Inc. (CFP Board), meaning you will not only earn your Bachelor of Science in Personal Financial Planning, but upon successful completion of the program, students are eligible to sit for the CFP® exam. The Personal Financial Planning program is the only program at K-State that offers classes that meet the educational requirements for the CFP® certification.
- A maximum of 60 credit hours from a community college will be applied toward the bachelor's degree.
- Transfer grades do not become part of your K-State GPA but may be referenced for consideration into specific programs.
- A grade of "D" will transfer to K-State but may not count toward degree requirements.
- General Education: K-State 8
Students who first enroll at K-State must meet the requirements of the K-State 8 General Education Program. The K-State 8 areas include:
 1. Aesthetic Interpretation
 2. Empirical and Quantitative Reasoning
 3. Ethical Reasoning and Responsibility
 4. Global Issues and Perspectives
 5. Historical Perspectives
 6. Human Diversity within the U.S.
 7. Natural and Physical Sciences
 8. Social Sciences
- PFP students will be in compliance with most of the K-State 8 requirements based on required courses for the major.
- An ^ next to the course indicates the course meets one of the K-State 8 requirements.
- Transfer students are required to cover all eight of the K-State areas. To assess information on designated courses for each area, see <http://www.k-state.edu/kstate8/>. Courses equivalent to K-State 8 courses in the designated areas may be transferred to satisfy area requirements.

It is the STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to check for updates to all transfer information. This transfer guide is provided as a service and is updated as needed. Degree requirements at the four-year colleges are subject to change by those institutions. To ensure you have the most accurate, up-to-date information about the program, it is imperative you meet with an advisor at the transfer institution.
